- **Personal guests of Regular Members are welcome provided they are accompanied by the member. Guests visiting more than occasionally should consider applying for a membership.**

I expressly acknowledge and agree that the activity of sailing is inherently dangerous and potentially hazardous and I hereby voluntarily agree to assume the risks and consequences of sailing at the Saskatoon Sailing Club.*
